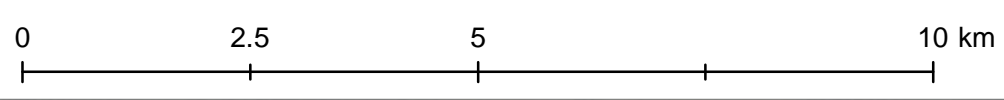

**Extent of Existing and Potentially Recoverable Priority Habitats, Lower Columbia River Reach D.**

Notes:

- Priority habitats in this Reach include herbaceous and wooded tidal wetlands, and forest and herbaceous uplands.
- For the purpose of this analysis, 'recoverable' habitats include habitat types which could potentially be restored to a priority habitat type.
